

Dear Placer Family,

The school year is off to a terrific start. Many thanks to the entire Placer Community including the faculty, staff, parents and of course those wonderful students! I have no doubt that this year will continue to be a wonderful experience for our Placer students.

One of the responsibilities of the PTC is to keep our community informed of events that impact our school and students. This fall an important initiative has been introduced to upgrade the buildings at Del Oro High School. Measure D is a \$40 million bond for the purposes of improving the infrastructure including new classrooms, improving existing buildings and creating an environment for improved learning that meets the needs of our students in the future. If passed, Measure D would also allow the state to match funds up to roughly \$18 million for a total of \$58 million. These funds would ONLY be used for Del Oro High School.

Measure D will be on the upcoming ballot in November. *The role of the PTC is not to sway your vote but rather to “inform” your vote.*

Make no mistake that this will impact every student currently at Placer that will migrate to Del Oro. I have attached an information sheet and also a link to an informational website on Measure D.
